



Our 2023 data reflects this change.





### St. John's School compared to National Average







In addition to the above grades, Further Maths contributed another 11 A\* - A grades which have not been included in the 80% A\* - A tally.


It is the consistency from G.C.S.E Maths to A Level Maths that is most pleasing. 74% of G.C.S.E. Maths grades were A\* - A this year.







### University of Cambridge to scrap its state school targets

Private school pupils in <u>England</u> are almost twice as likely as their state school peers to go to a more selective university, <u>Government</u> figures show.


The gap between pupils in private and state schools progressing to a "high tariff" institution – universities with higher entry requirements – has widened, according to the latest <u>Department for Education</u> (DfE) data.

A social mobility expert called the figures a "national scandal" and warned that the idea that anyone can study for a degree is becoming "a distant dream".

The figures show private school A-level pupils had a 67.8% progression rate to a more selective university by the age of 19 compared to their peers in state schools who had a 34.2% progression rate.

The gap between independent and state school pupils in England – 33.6 percentage points – is the widest it has been since 2017/18.






